

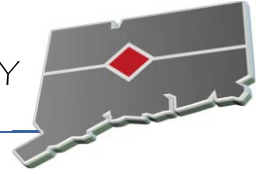

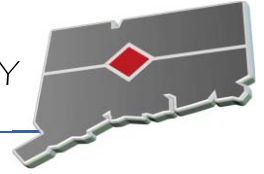

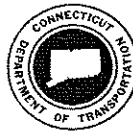

Project Description (short): 28 (30 Characters)	Plymouth:Fall Mt. Water Rd.
Project Description (long): 135 (257 Characters)	This project will reconstruct a 780 foot section of Allentown Road (contained within the Fall Mountain Lake Area) to a 28 foot width and install catch basins and curbing where required.

Justification: 605 (1333 Characters)	This project will improve safety, the vertical geometry and life cycle of the roadway. Funding for this project has been established under the Consolidated Appropriations Act, 2008, Division K, Title 1, Section 129 Surface Transportation Projects; Demo ID CT167-Fall Mountain Water Road Paving, Plymouth,CT. This project is 100% Federally funded. The designated amount available per Pub.L. No.110-161 is \$500,000. However, that amount is subject to a 2% rescission, therefore total federal funding for the project is \$490,000. The Town will perform and seek reimbursement for all right-of -way activities.
