II. Action Item - Offer to voluntarily consolidate the Central Connecticut Regional Planning Organization with the Council of Governments of Central Naugatuck Valley.

The Executive Director introduced the subject with a brief overview of the options available to the Region for consolidation or dismemberment. There was discussion about the positions taken by various of the Chief Elected Officials (CEOs) and town councils. It was noted that some Board members felt compelled to vote in accordance with the wishes of their CEOs, while others felt that they needed to act on the basis of their own knowledge of the form and functions of the Agency. MOTION: Rudy Cabata moved to table the matter for further discussion at the next meeting; seconded by Stephen Mindera; passed with Chairman Kern in opposition.

MOTION: Don Padlo moved to direct staff to attend meetings of each of the Region's municipalities to help the City/Town Councils better understand the issues involved in the potential consolidations and what alternatives exist; seconded Stephen Mindera; passed unanimously.
